The M. A. Lambrecht Vocational Scholarship

The M. A. Lambrecht Scholarship was established as an investment in non-college bound students who are motivated to pursue further education. The award reflects Anne's belief that our youth are our future. Selected students may qualify for the scholarship for two years. A second year of the scholarship is based upon successfully passing all courses during the first year.

The scholarship is directed at a graduating senior from one of the three Billings public high schools for use in further vocational or technical training within the state of Montana. The **Scholarship Award is \$500 each year for two years.** Funds are disbursed directly to the institution of higher learning after the Scholarship recipient has matriculated. **Students in a four-year college program do NOT qualify for this scholarship.**

The scholarship Selection Committee will use the following criteria to determine the scholarship winner:

- Demonstrated interest and commitment to a career path.
- Individual initiative or involvement in extracurricular activities or an after-school job which exemplify commitment, responsibility, strong work ethic, and respect for others.
- Academic achievement with a minimum GPA of 2.5 in high school.
- The award is for post secondary vocational or technical education in Montana.

Applicant Requirements:

- Be a graduating senior from Billings Public Schools.
- Neatly and thoroughly fill out application and return to your guidance counselor.
- Household income at or below \$66,200 based on IRS tax return (2015 Montana Median Household Income using Housing and Urban Development statistics).
- Submit with the application a copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from a school official, teacher, counselor, employer, and/or activity sponsor.

The Scholarship award will be presented at the annual awards assembly held at the student's high school in May. The scholarship recipient should be present. For further information, please contact Krista Hertz, Education Foundation, at 245-4133. Thank you.
